

Connecting Using WebDAV on Windows 2000 and XP

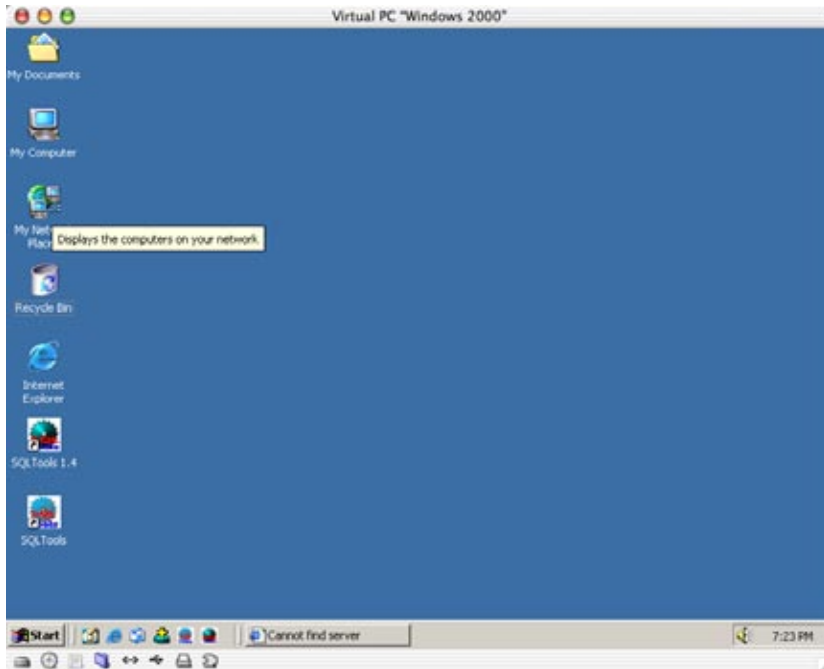
WebDAV Tutorial using Windows 2000 or XP

Requirements: Windows 2000, or 98/ME or NT with IE 6 installed

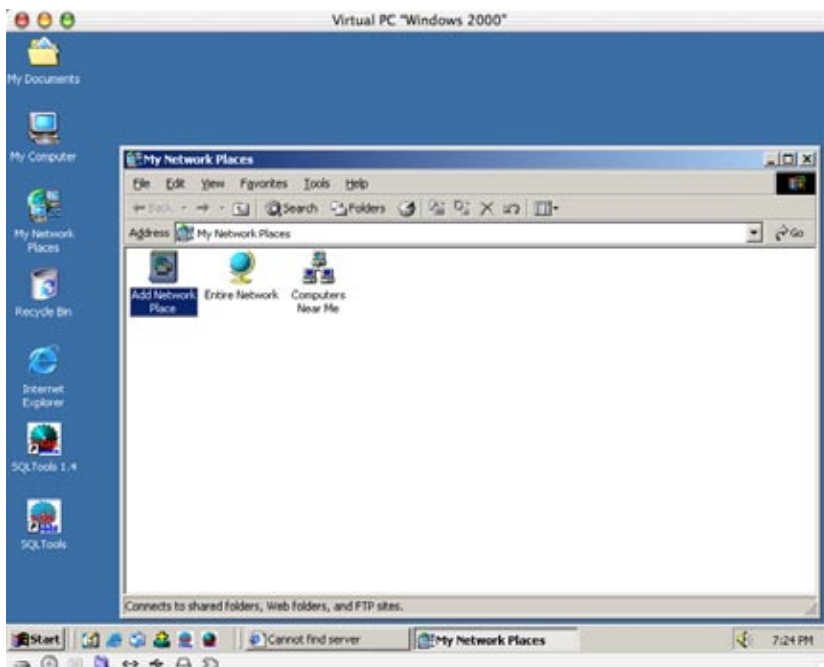
Please note: This tutorial has been tested with Windows 2000 and XP. All steps are applicable to both except Step 3.

Step 1



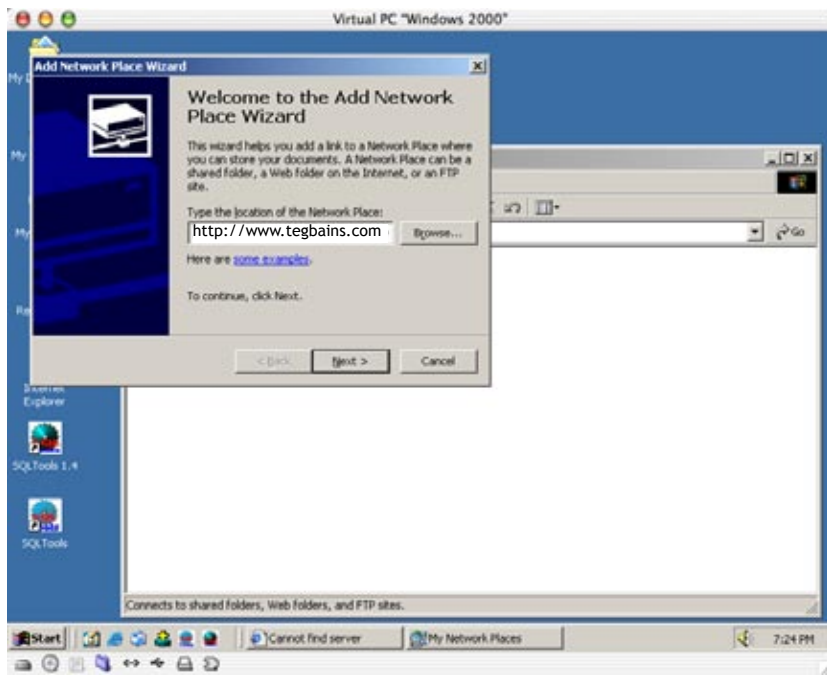
Double click on My Network Places.

Step 2



Double click on Add Network Place.

Step 3

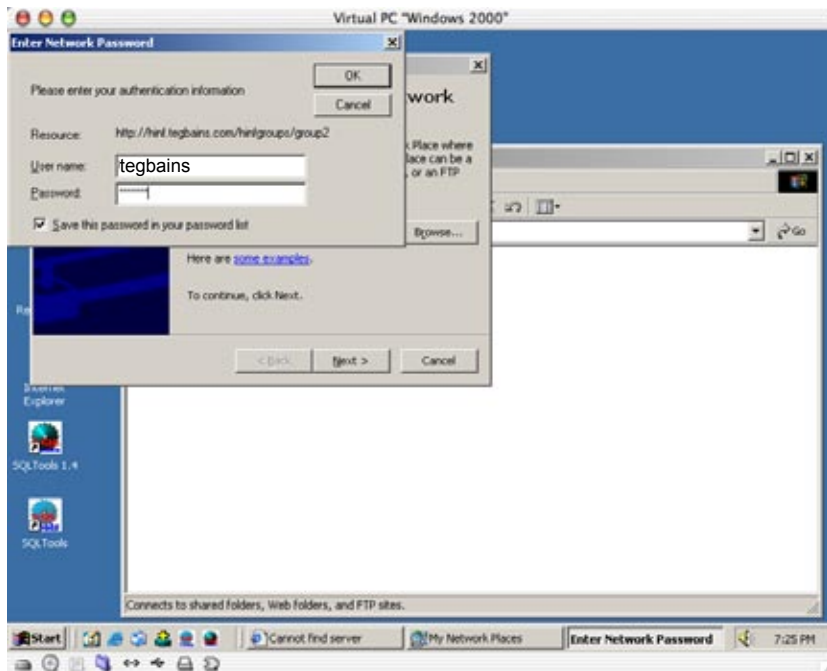


For Windows 2000: Type in: `http://www.yoursite.com` (ie: `http://www.tegbains.com`)

For Windows XP: Type in: `http://www.yoursite.com:80` (ie: `http://www.tegbains.com:80`)

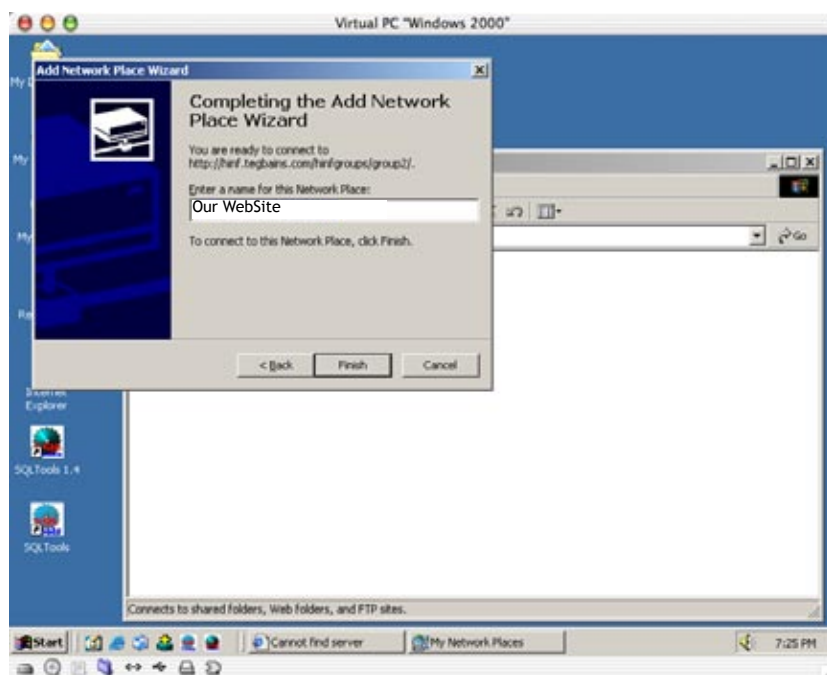
Now, click on Next

Step 4



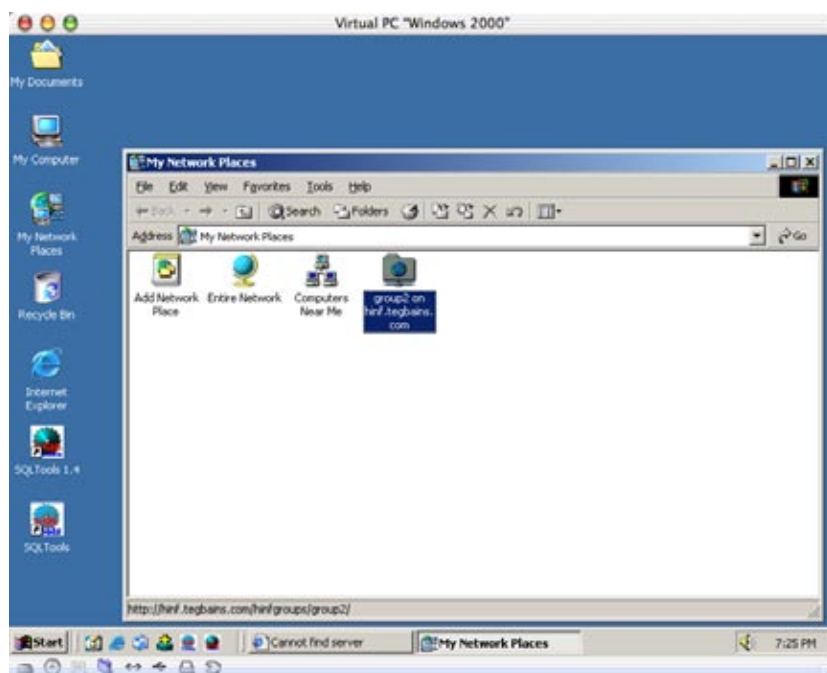
Type in your username (ie: `tegbains`) and password. If you wish to have Windows remember your username password, make sure that "Save this password in your password list" is selected. Now click OK.

Step 5



Choose a name for this connection (ie: Our WebSite) and click on Finish.

Step 6



Done. Now you may explore your website and download and upload files for your website.
